SanDestin was the Rotary Place to Be Last Weekend!



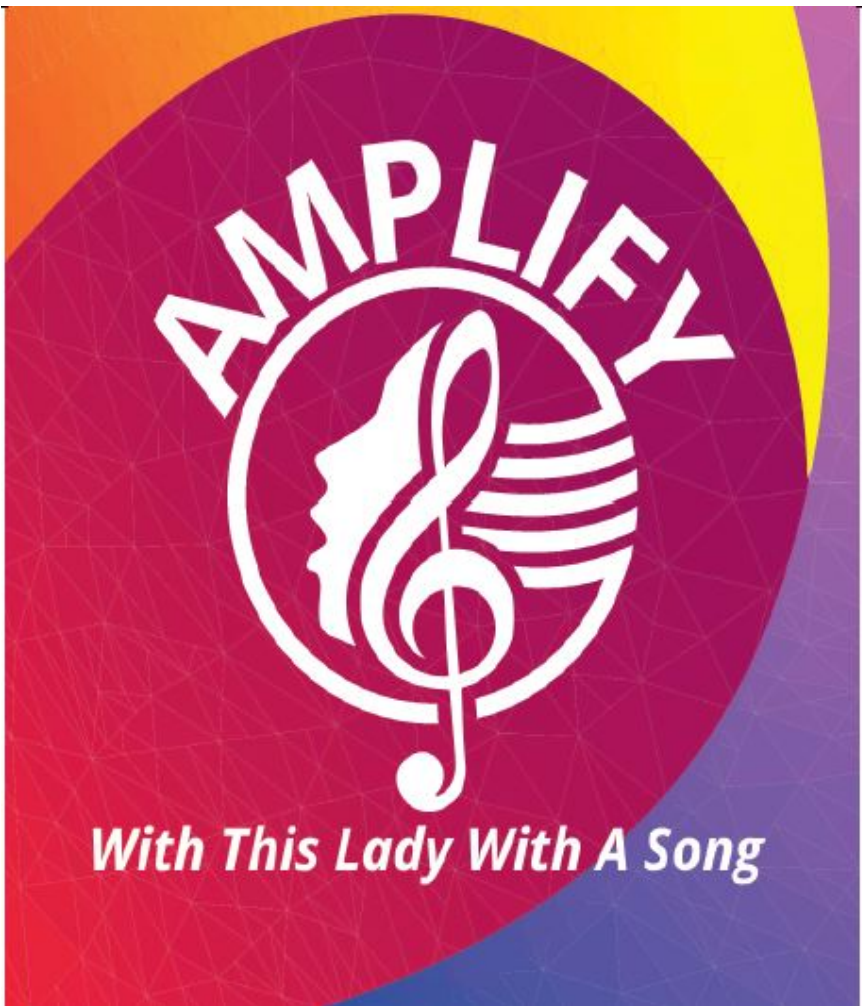
